All the juices are from biodynamically growned grapes from the Côte des Bar, with no blend and special care to the details and differences between parcels of different expositions.

DOMAINE DE BICHERY

Domaine de Bichery was created by Raphaël and Hannah Piconnet in 2015 in the heart of the Côte des Bar when Raphaël took over the family estate after a few vintages in Burgundy, Bordeaux and Switzerland.

The estate is composed of 8 hectares of vine, all organic farmed, split between the production of limited cuvées for the domaine and the supply of the local cooperative.

While Raphaël was born and raised in the Côte des Bar, Hannah hailed from Germany and they both met in Bordeaux in 2012 while Raphaël was working in Pessac-Leognan.

The couple always had a clear vision of the direction of the estate – a full conversion to organic farming, the deep expression of terroir character and the production of unique cuvées, from different blends and small single vineyards.

CHAMPAGNE ÉRIC RODEZ

Éric Rodez, along with his wife Martine, are the 8th generation of a family of Champagne makers, with origins dating back from 1757. The Rodez couple have established a 6.12 hectares domaine located in Ambonnay – and Éric himself was the Mayor of the city from 2008 to 2014!

Subdivided in 35 different parcels with 62% of Pinot Noir and 38% of Chardonnay, planted in fairly high altitudes (130 meters), this is an ideal set up to grow outstanding Pinot Noir. After a long time working for Champagne Krug as an oenolgist, Éric undoubtably acquired an experience and outstanding know-how in blending.

The 9th generation of the Rodez family – Mickaël and Aurélie have recently joined the estate, learning from their parents about this strong heritage.

Romain Hénin is one of this new generation of Champagne grower to watch – after graduating in viticulture in Avize, he was trained for 2 years at Domaine Henri Giraud in Aÿ, growing its interest from organic and biodynamic principles.

While working at the Hénin family estate, Romain gradually set up his own domaine of 1.2 hectares since 2016, with a successful conversion to revive the soils.

With only 1300 bottles produced each vintage (equivalent of 5 barrels!) for now, this is a gem to watch, even more since he has fully acquired the family estate in 2021, with a strong commitment to convert and revamp it at its image.

CHAMPAGNE LES FRÈRES MIGNON

The two brothers Florent and Julien are the last generation of a long time family of champagne growers. In 2014, they decided to finally produce their own label and 2016 was their first harvest, assisted by their father into this new project.

They were lucky to inherit some parcels in the best areas of La Côte des Blancs - from their mother family side, a parcel in Grand Cru of Avize, and from their father family side, a parcel in Grand Cru of Cramant and in Premier Cru of Cuis – the whole estate composed of 90% Chardonnay and 10% Pinot Noir.

The two brothers produced only 6000 bottles per year and are definitely part of this new generation in Champagne to watch.

CHAMPAGNE AURÉLIEN LEMAIRE

Aurélien Lemaire is a young winemaker who joined the family estate Champagne Claude Lemaire in 2016.

Located in Bousault in the heart of Vallée de la Marne, the estate is composed of 5ha of 18 different parcels.

Since then he worked consciously to organic converted the estate and modern all the winemaking processes, while advocating for a lower level of intervention, to let all the terroir expresses itself.

In 2018, he inherited 2ha of vines and started to produce his own Champagne, with 2019 being his first own vintage released, making a very promising debut.





CHAMPAGNE PIERRE DEVILLE

The Domaine Pierre Deville has been cultivating vines for 4 generations in the Grand Cru village of Verzy, in the heart of Montagne de Reims.

Since 1963, they are producing champagnes under their own name, and today the young great-grandson of the founder Alban Corbeaux continues the family traditions.

He took over the estate in 2016 and decided to work only biodymically since then, with the greatest respect for the terroir in the most natural way possible.

The estate is composed of 5 hectares all in the Verzy Grand Cru area, with 60% of Chardonnay and 40% of Pinot Noir.

Alban is part of this young and promising new generation, perpetuating the champagne traditions while bringing a modern touch to the production.

LA GRANGE DE L'ONCLE CHARLES

Jérôme François and Morgane Stoquert are producing atypical wines from Alsace, with a great character.

Installed in Ostheim since 2014, after a life as a carpenter, Jérôme started his own domaine from a few ares here and there and an old barn from his great uncle Charles, paying tribute to him in the name of the estate. His mentor, the famous Alsacian Marcel Deiss, definitely had an influence on his philosophy and vision about viticulture.

Following biodynamic principles, the couple is helped by Sirus and Fastoche, the two horses working in the vineyards, as well with a pack of black sheep for natural grazing.

The entirety of the 5.5 hectares vineyard is co-planted, with old, middle-aged and young vines replaced from time to time all together, thriving on a diversity of soils. A sensitive approach to the fruits, the vines, and all the ecosystem around, resulting in elegant wines, yet with their own subtle touch.

Trained in Bordeaux but passionate about the Loire Valley, all the wines produced by Nicolas are natural, from organic farming with a committed philosophy of respect of the soil and the grapes.

With only 7 hectares composed of 5 hectares of Cabernet Franc and 2 hectares of Chenin Blanc, his wines are true expressions of the terroir of Anjou, with a unique character. No over-maturity, long maceration in various tanks such as amphoras, concrete vats and very little wood are the motto of Nicolas and his wife, Sylvie Auguereau - also a winemaker in the Anjou region.

Sylvie and her husband Nicolas are both very committed and passionate about their work and the impact of it, with a strong philosophy that we can find and taste in those bottles.

He came back to his roots in the Loire Valley, where he is currently biodynamically farming this small vineyard like he would do "in his garden" according to Dominique.

The Aussigouins parcel is located nearby the famous parcel of Les Noëls de Montbenaults of Richard Leroy, where the Chenin Blanc is thriving on schist and spilit soils. Dominique is renting the other half of the parcel to the Japanese couple Mai and Kenji Hodgson.

Working on very small yields to value quality over quantity, following natural principles and delicate fermentation. The wines from Dominique are indeed confidential, but something worth to try.

Abel Benmaamar, long time wine lover, firstly trained as a pharmaceutical engineer made the big change in 2015 and switched his career for a viticulture program. He made his first steps in the vineyards in Beaujolais at Domaine Thillardon, then Domaine Vin in Roussillon and then with Patrick Corbineau in the Loire Valley, where he simply fell in love with the area.

After graduating in 2018, his dream became reality when he took over some parts of the vineyards and estate of formerly known as Domaine des Roches Sèches.

Composed of 4 hectares of approximatively 30 years old vines located in the area of Martigné-Briand, all conducted in biological farming with a vast majority of Chenin Blanc, and a little bit of Cabernet Franc.

Why 7 ? Coming from his eternal search of esthetics and beauty in wines, with a perfect angular shape, like an ideal to achieve.

JEAN-BAPTISTE HARDY

Jean-Baptiste Hardy is one these young winemakers revamping the Muscadet appellation. After his training at Domaine Roulot and Domaine Leflaive, and working in vineyards all around the world including Patagonia (Bodega Chacra), California (Domaine de la Côte) and New Zealand (Fromm Winery), he took over his family estate in 2018 located in Muscadet-Sèvre-et-Maine.

The estate in composed of 4 hectares planted only with the local variety – Melon de Bourgogne, only from massale selection, from the 1950s and 1960s. Planted on typical Muscadet terroir: complex soils of gabbros (volcanic soils and fragmented granite), silica and clay. He also has a small negoce activity for producing some outstanding red Loire valley blends.

2020 was his first own vintage, and it is already a name to watch.

HENRI CHAUVET

Henri Chauvet is bringing back the Auvergne region on the wine map of France. In the Spring of 2021, Henri bought the 10.5 hectares estate from iconic local winemaker Annie Sauvat locared in Boudes and made his first yet promising vintage.

Before becoming a winemaker, Henri was working in corporate banking, and left the industry to get a viticulture degree and was trained for many years in the Rhône Valley, working alongside Thierry Allemand in Cornas and Jerome Bressy of Domaine Gourt de Mautens in Rasteau, before coming back to his roots in Auvergne.

Henri is farming 10.5 hectares of the most promising varieties of the region – 60% of Gamay, 30% of Pinot Noir and 10% of Chardonnay, while biodynamically converting the estate. With a deep understanding of the various types of soils underneath his vines – from pink granite, quartz, volcanic marble to sandy clay, each cuvée is already showing a precise sense of place.

MAISON POMMIER

The Maison is run in Poinchy by the couple of Isabelle and Denis since 1990 when they took over

the 2 hectares of the Pommier family land, the production was then sold in bulk to negociants. In 1994/1995, the winery is built and the production is now sold under the label of Maison Pommier, to reveal all the potential of the vines and wines on its own, planted in both Chablis and Petit Chablis appellations (23 hectares in total today). Always in the search of perfection and new projects, the couple has been producing red wines (Irancy and Bourgogne Rouge) since 2007, and in 2012 they expanded the vineyards with two parcels of Chablis Premier Cru, Fourchaume and Beauroy.

The terroir of Chablis is so unique with a type of soil only found in this area, the Kimmeridgian, composed of layers of limestone, soft clay and fossilised marine organisms that dates back to the Jurassic period.

Claude Maréchal is the embodiment of a true "vigneron" with an authentic vision of the vine growing with no chemicals and the use of indegenous yeast, with total manual labor and a perfectionist way of working in the cellar.

Trained by well-known winemakers in Burgundy, Camille is now producing only a few barrels each year in various villages in both red and white. With a very artisanal and hand-made vision, and yet with a modern spirit of this new generation of winemakers in Burgundy.

Still under the radar, we have no doubt of the potential and brilliant future of the domaine for the next vintages to come.

With full respect of the vineyard traditions, the couple has a young and modern vision on the technic, and the result is definitely distinguishable.

DOMAINE PIERRE THIBERT

Pierre and his wife Aline are self-made wine makers, and with no background in viticulture, they managed to build a family owned estate of 5 hectares with a long time pristine reputation.

Out of passion, Pierre established the domaine in 1989 by renting a few parcels at first, then expanding the estate as it is today, with half in Côte de Nuits and half in Côte de Beaune - and it is probably one of the best kept secret of Burgundy ever since.

Since 2017, their son Arthur is taking over the reins, keeping the family heritage alive, while committing to the modernization of the domaine. A new cuverie has been built, and the work in the vineyard is conscious, with organic farming methods, elevating the quality vintage after vintage.

Great respect for nature, conscious work in the vineyard and attention to details, definitely a name to keep an eye on.

DOMAINE THOMAS-COLLARDOT

The estate is quite new on the map of Puligny-Montrachet – established in 2010, when Jacqueline inherited this 2.5ha plot from her father Pierre Thomas, who was the winemaker until 1992. The vineyard originates three generations back from the Henry Chavy estate, and from 1992 to 2010, her cousins Phillippe and Hubert Chavy were in charged.

The first vintage produced under the name Thomas-Collardot was 2015, and the quality, precision, and energy just keep growing. Since then, Jacqueline assisted by her son Matthieu have add a few new parcels to the estate, from different villages to Premier Cru appellations, all in Puligny-Montrachet.

All the vineyards of the estate are organically certified since 2020, and Jacqueline and Matthieu are practicing sustainable winemaking, while doing all the work by hand or by horse. The wines are usually spending two winters in barrels to undergo a slow elevage on lees, with very little new wood. Their aim is to expressed the subtility of the various Puligny-Montrachet terroirs with a handful of detailed and classic Puligny-Montrachet micro-cuvées.

MAISON A&S

Maison A&S was established in 2018 by a young duo of winemakers and longtime friends from Burgundy – Pierre-Alexandre Soltana and Alexandre Aires, with the idea to set up a high quality micro-négoce activity, from the sourcing of the grapes to the maturation.

While searching for a suitable infrastructure, they began their journey by renting a 17th-century vaulted cellar in Chagny, where they crafted their first three vintages: 2018, 2019, and 2020. In 2021, they acquired a winery and a few plots around Nantoux and Pommard in the Hautes Côtes de Beaune region, focus in Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, as well as Aligoté.

While developing their own project, Pierre-Alexandre is currently the head of viticulture at Domaine des Comtes Lafon, while Alexandre is the cellar master at Domaine Thibault Liger-Belair. Respecting the traditional ways of Burgundy while bringing a fresh modern eye, Maison A&S is definitely a duo to watch.

DOMAINE BONNARDOT

The Bonnardot domain was founded in 1981 in Bonnencontre by the mother Élisabeth Bonnardot, coming from a strong Burgundian history with a family making wine since 1470. She already had a modern view on viticulture as she studied oenology and did an apprenticeship with organic wine master Jules Chauvet.

Her two sons Ludovic and Emilien took over the vineyards from their mother in 2005. They shared the love for organic viticulture with their mother and continued the trend that Élisabeth had started.

Today, the domain is entirely biodynamic, although not certified, while the two brothers are working on 15 hectares, 18 different appellations and more than 50 different parcels mostly in Santenay and Hautes Côtes de Beaune area, while the cellar located in the middle of the vineyards of Saint Aubin.

DOMAINE ROBERT-DENOGENT

The Domaine dates back to the beginning of the XXth century, handled by the Robert-Denogent family ever since. The wines are the result of a perfect timing of picking, slow extended elevage in barrels, with a quality and complexity that can compete with their famous Northern counterparts of Burgundy.

Today, the last generation is in charge, with Nicolas and Antoine.

DOMAINE DE LA GRAPP'A

Aurélie Parla and Julien Maublanc created Domaine la Grapp'a working their first vintage in 2021. Both from Jura, the 5 hectares of vines of the domaine have been in Julien's family for generations, worked organically for the local cooperative. Located in the village of Abergement-le-Grand, just 5km outside of Arbois, the vineyard always had a tremendous potential, that the couple are finally expressing under its own label.

Composed of many very qualitative and well exposed plots of old massales of Chardonnay, both yellow and green Savagnin, Pinot Noir as well as the local reds – Trousseau and Poulsard. While working on the biodynamic conversation of the current vines, Aurélie and Julien are also planting 2.5 hectare of young vines which will be ready in 2025.

Following the work in the vineyards, Aurélie and Julien are very precise and careful in their winemaking, with the next vintage delivering many different cuvées experimenting different macerations time. The white wines are then aged mostly in old barrels in a historical limestone cellar in the basement dating of the XVIth century.

DOMAINE LES ARICOQUES

Since 2021, the duo of winemakers and longtime friends Romain Dupont and Guillaume Bellon have taken over a 4.80 estate located in the small village of Frangy in the mountains of Haute-Savoie.

Passionate, proud of their roots and their terroir, the estate is today in conversion and planted with local star varieties - Altesse, Roussette, Jacquère, Mondeuse and Gamay.

The special soil of the domaine makes all the difference – called Moraine Glacière, it is a very poor soil resulting in low yields of very high quality and concentration. With a Southern exposure at 500 meters of altitude, it is an ideal combination for wine growing.

Why Pan!? The habitants of the Frangy village are called les Frangypans, and it reminds us the sound of the cork being pulled out the bottle. Sweet music to our ears.

A most sought-after and yet under the radar domaine in Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Clos des Brusquières is handle by the Courtil Thibaut family since 1969 when Claude Courtil, trained by Henri Bonneau, set up his own domaine nearby the Château. Located in the Northern part of the Châteauneuf-du-Pape village, the vineyard is composed of the 13 grapes varieties that give all the magic to the blends of this appellation.

With an average age of 50 years, all the focus of the domaine is toward the 10 hectares of old vines of the Clos des Brusquières to make a unique style of expression of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Since 2015, the two sons of Claude, David and Jérome, are now carrying the family legacy.

MAISON CLUSEL ROCH

An iconic domaine run by the Clusel family for four generations on the slopes of Côte Rotie in the Rhône Valley and on the hills of Coteaux du Lyonnais. The first parcels Syrah were planted in 1935 by Baptiste Clusel.

With only 20 hectares of vines (17 hectares in red and 3 hectares in white), entirely organically farmed since the end of the 1990s. It's a family business

of passionate winegrowers and winemakers, peticulars on the details with "home-made" vine grafting, massales selections, and manual labour of very steep slopes of very old vines of Serines - the traditional version of the Syrah in Ampuis.

Today, Guillaume Clusel has taken over the reins of the domaine alongside his parents, keeping on the traditional way of working in the vines and in the cellar, however bringing his younger modern aspirations for the future of the Maison.

Biodynamically farmed since 2005, David works in total respect with the terroir, nature and his vines, giving all the complexity in the bottle.

DOMAINE SALADIN

Domaine Saladin is a real family business, the historical archives testifies of the roots of the Saladin domaine in 1422! Since then, 21 generations of the family have kept the tradition alive, and the estate is now under the hands of the Saladin sisters - Elisabeth and Marie Laurence.

THIBAUD CAPELLARO

Since 2018 as a young winemaker, established between Condrieu, Côte-Rôtie and St-Joseph, Thibaud is finding its own path, breaking with the conventions of these famous appellations.

Born and raised in the region, however with no tied from winemaking, he chose after his business studies to follow his passion for wine. He managed to acquire a few parcels of a total of 2 hectares, planted and unplanted, often overlooked by the older generations as not South exposed. Thibaud made an real bet, believing in his project and with the rise of the temperature, this turns out to be beneficial. A great challenge indeed, to work in one of the steepest vineyards in France, following organic farming and natural winemaking, which is still relatively avant-garde for the region.

Thibaud also managed a micro-negoce structure called Slope, carefully sourcing the best organic grapes in the area, from Ardèche, Monts du Lyonnais, Gard and even Piemonte in Italy!

Honest wines, with great depth and character and full of ambition, it is one of the young Southern talents to follow.

DOMAINE ZURIA

The project was initiated in 2010 by Dominique Zuria to restore the vine growing around the village of Bonifacio, in the extreme South of the Island, disseminated by the phylloxera outbreak.

Nadine and Christian took over this tremendous project, associated with Yves Canarelli, to conduct researches on different terroirs and soils, on native grape varieties to replant an entire vineyard - and their first vintage was born in 2016.

The cellar is located in the heart of Bonifacio, however the 13 hectares of vines are split between several parcels and area providing a variety of terroir – Stintinu, Musella, Spinella and Santa Giulia. The vineyard is currently undergoing its biodynamic conversion.

Focusing on the main indigenous varieties – Sciacarellu and Vermentinu – the estate is also working some forgotten varieties, usually to support the blend.

A bold project and a deep philosophy to re lend the prestige to the Bonifacio appellation.




PRIEURÉ SAINT JEAN DE BÉBIAN

The story of Prieuré Saint Jean de Bébian dates back to the Roman Empire, as the vineyard would have been a reward for winning multiple wars to the centurion Bébianus. Then the estate was sold to local monks who built up a monastery (hence the name Prieuré) and a vineyard.

The estate was lately in the news due to a few changes of ownerships – bought in 1991 by the former owners of La Revue des Vins de France, then acquired along with Domaine Ganevat in Jura in 2015 by the Russian Alexander Pumpyansky, and recently taken over by its long time winemaker Benoit Pontenier

Benoit is the talent behind the revival of this old state, now composed of 19 hectares of old and young vines, all in biodynamic farming. In the cellar, very few interventions and using wild yeasts without any filtration in perfect harmony with the terroir and its surrounding.

Following the golden era of the wines from Langlade, appreciated by Louis XIV and Thomas Jefferson, this confidential appellation located in the heart of Languedoc deserves one's attention. The domaine Edgard Dufès is an historical reference of this area of the South West of France, now run by Elisabeth Van Der Bent since 2001, keeping the former family name of the estate. The Langlade Red is composed of a subtle blend of Syrah, Cinsault, Grenache and Mourvèdre, to translate all the heritage of the appellation. With only 3.5 hectares of 80 years old vines and a production of 9000 bottles per vintage, this is a true hidden gem.

LA NOUVELLE DON(N)E

As stated by its name, Domaine de la Nouvelle Don(n)e is aspiring to a new vision of the Southern wines, with a modern philosophy of winemaking in this area. This ambitious promise was made by Wilfried Valat when he set up his own 5 hectares estate, la Nouvelle Don(n)e, in 2007 in the mountains of the Pyrénées Orientales.

A true craftsman of the grapes, with an almost burgundian way of working giving an elegant and unique expression of this somehow under-looked region. Indeed, Wilfried was trained with some of the finest Pinot Noir growers of Burgundy, Domaine Meo-Camuzet in Vosne-Romanée and Domaine Joblot in Givry.

DOMAINE INEBRIATI

The domaine was created in 2010 by Victor Beau with only 2 hectares in metayage from his father, a pioneer of biodynamic farming in the region.

Firstly trained as a physiotherapist, Victor came back to the family winemaking roots quickly. Today, the domaine counts 7 hectares of old vines planted in the middle of the garrigue surrounded by limestone hills, at the Northest point of the Pic-Saint-Loup appellation in the South West of France.

Influenced by a Mediterranean climate with warming Summers with high winds, the vineyard are meticulously handled with care.

Nothing added and no new wood are the two guidelines of the domaine, retaining all the fruitiness of a myriad of Southern, often forgotten, varieties, with an extensive range of cuvées carrying mythologic names.

VINYA DEL COLL

The Vinya del Coll is located in a small south-facing plot, on the historic family estate of a viticulturist linega that dates back more than 500 years, in Sant Sadurní d'Anoia – Penedés, on the Mediterranean Spanish coastline. This is where Pepe Raventós and Vincent Pastorello decided to unleash this new project.

Pepe Raventòs is from one of the oldest winemaking families in Spain, but also very passionate and not afraid of taking risks – in 2012 he left the appellation Cava D.O (created by his own grandfather!) and obtained the right to create a new denomination, Conca del Riu Anoia D.O, where he is currently the only one producing under this particular appellation. Famous for his high quality Méthode Traditionelle sparkling from indigenous grapes, expressing their origin and terroir.

While Vincent Pastorello is an esteemed sommelier, former Head of Wine of The Dorchester and currently Global Wine and Beverage Manager from Dream International Group – he followed his dream of making his own wine.

This collaboration was born in 2021 on the Vinya del Coll parcel - a plot of only 1.6 hectare of calcareous-clay soils, specially chosen to produce Xarel Lo and planted in 1965, following biodynamic viticulture and only worked with the help of two horses.





AUDEANT WINES

After their first visit in Oregon in 2015, Teal Walker and her partner, originally from Chicago, fell in love with the region and their wines. The winery was founded in the Willamette Valley in 2016 by Teal and Andrew Riechers, a native Oregonian winemakers with a stellar resume, with various experience in Oregon of course (Antica Terra), but also in California (Summerland Winery), in New-Zealand (Burn Cottage) and in Burgundy (Domaine Naudin Ferrand).

Starting only with a few rows throughout the valley on several of the most challenging and compelling vineyard sites of the area, now the estate is nested around Luminous Hills, Carlisle's Crest, Nysa and Cherry Grove vineyards, with a total of 6 hectares planted of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

With a deep ambition, long term thinking on organic farming and old vines, the resulting partnership has been nothing short of extraordinary. They are building slowly, and for legacy with their end-goal of being known as a top-tiered producer of benchmark Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

The name Audeant is Latin for - may they dare, may they venture, may they risk - and was aptly chosen to serve as a guiding light for never taking the easy way out in their approach to winemaking, vineyard sourcing, and living life to the fullest.
